Help Wanted for Rollerskating!!

The Lambertville Presbyterian Church's Friday Night Roller Skating program is seeking an individual to be director(s) of roller skating starting in November 2020. Cooie and Desre Pidcock are retiring from that position as of April 2020 after 20 years of service.

On Friday night during the winter months children in sixth grade and under attend free skating from 6pm to 8pm in our church's activity building. As this is a mission outreach of the church, a short (5 to 10 minute) Bible study lesson is given for the children around 7 pm.

The director will need to start about 5:40 pm by setting up chairs, music, lights, and checking bathrooms. While the children are there, the director will oversee the activities to ensure safety and can introduce "corner games" and other variations that the children enjoy. After the Bible lesson, children are invited to participate in races, in which they compete against others in their grade level (for example, first and second grade boys or fifth and sixth grade girls). The races are very popular among the children. It is necessary to have some volunteer assistants, as the director must be focused on the skating area, rather than the snack table. When the skating session ends, the director will have to do general clean-up of the floor, seating areas and bathrooms so the gym can be used for the "teen hang" program that begins at 8 pm.

If you enjoy meeting people and having fun with kids, this is the position for you! Friday Night Skating is in its 63rd year and going strong. Please contact Sue at the church office or contact Cooie for more information.



Clerks Correspondence and Session Mail Box Part 1- Susan McCloughan

Review of Minutes: Session reviewed the minutes from the January 20, 2020 Session Business Meeting. A **motion** was called to accept the Minutes as written. All were in favor. The approved Minutes will be sent to Sue/Church Office to be printed in the Book of Minutes and to be included in the Church Newsletter. There was a **motion** for the Agenda for tonight's meeting to be approved, all were in favor.

Moderator Molly Dykstra, Cherry Oakley and Liaison David Redman from the New Brunswick Presbytery-

Molly is the Current Pastor and Cherry Oakley is a Ruling Elder at First Presbyterian of Trenton. They came to speak to the Session regarding how our church can be more connected with the Presbytery. The letter from Pastor Gregory was discussed at the meeting, that was sent to the Presbytery when he retired. The letter brought to light a few issues so it was discussed on how we can improve our relationship with the Presbytery and its members. Rev. Tomlinson also commented on how would we like to be more connected. More relationship development was discussed to improve that between the churches. David Redman discussed the Committee on Ministry and that possibly to keep the Liaison on after finding a pastor, to be able to check in with the church/congregation. A Stated Meeting of the Presbytery will be held on Tuesday March 10, 2020, time to be announced. It was encouraged that our Elders attend. This portion of the meeting was ended in prayer.

Calendar Highlights from February-May 2020: The Ordination/Installation Sunday is February 23rd. We will need to have an Ordained Minister for that service for the Ordination/Installation. Heather Pursell organized Soup Sales during the month of February to raise funds for the Mission Trip to the Dominican Republic in the fall of 2020. Turning the clocks Ahead 1 Hour on Sunday Morning 3/8 at 2:00 am. The last week for Skating, Friday Night Hang and Lambertville Basketball League is March 13th and 14th. There is No Women's Bible Study during Lent. On Palm Sunday April 5th at 4:00 pm, there is a Community Church Cantata and Pot Luck at Kirkpatrick. The Maundy Thursday Service is at Mt. Airy at 7:00 pm and The Good Friday Service is at Kirkpatrick in Ringoes at 7:00 pm. Easter Sunday April 12th, is the Deacon Breakfast at 8:30 am, Easter Egg Hunt, and Worship at 10:30. April 25 & 26 is Shad Fest weekend. Our church will be worshipping with New Hope Community Church. More details to follow. The New Hope CC Youth Group will not be in the Gym on April 26th, due to the Chamber of Commerce in the Gym. Sundays in May were discussed, 5/3, 5/10 and 5/24.

Clerks Correspondence and Session Mail Box Part 2-

Bob Tomlinson discussed with Session the process of getting a new pastor, and how a permanent pastor will help the overall church stay more positive, than if having to change pastors every few years.

Don "Cooie" Pidcock gave a letter to Session that he and Desre will be retiring from being the Directors of the Skating on Friday Nights after the 2020 Season. We are to look to the Congregation for a replacement for Cooie and Desre to take over the Skating. Session thanked Cooie for all his and Desre's years of service for the Friday Night Skating program. An "Advertisement" will be put in the upcoming Bulletins and Newsletters asking for new Directors for the Friday Night Skating program.

The Newton Presbytery-An email handout was given to Session regarding the combination of the Presbyteries. David Redman spoke to Session regarding the Presbytery changing. New boundaries are being worked on. The Elizabeth and New Brunswick Presbyteries are discussed. More information to come in the months ahead.

Shad Fest 2020- The Lambertville Chamber of Commerce (COC) Sent in a deposit to rent the Gym for Shad Fest. They will be occupying the Gym on April 24, 25 and 26. Our church will be selling hot dogs/grilling for the Shad Fest. We need to get the Permit to Sell from City Hall. Sue from the Church Office will call and obtain the form and have one of the Elders to complete and return.

The Iron Fence in front of the Church- Two estimates to fix the fence were obtained. More details will be discussed at an upcoming Session Business Meeting.

Building and Grounds- Pat Durborow/Don Pidcock/Heather McIntyre

Kitchen updates- The church members will be coming in to clean the kitchen on February 22, 2020 at 9:00 am. Session discussed replacing the counter on the island, cleaning and possibly painting the cabinets. Most likely, the gas stove will be replaced with another gas stove. Grace Reading will be consulted when a new gas stove is going to be purchased.

Don Pidcock did some work on our flagpole that is in the Church Cemetery. He replaced the rope on the flagpole, so the flag can be in better working order. He also discussed with Session the George Prall Trust and its importance to Lambertville. Cooie suggested that our new pastor (when they arrive) be on that committee. The Plaque for Dr. Henry, to possibly to be placed in the Gym, will be discussed at a later date.

Reiner Heating- The furnaces are still being worked on. Phil, Nate, Pat D. and Cooie will get together in the near future after church to talk about how to resolve the problems with the furnace and how the problems can be resolved in regard to the back, boiler room. We keep getting an alarm for that area of the church, and how that room needs to be/stay more ventilated. A **motion** was brought to the table to assess where we are in regards to our contract with Reiner and getting a committee together to see if we can get another company/new heating contract. The **motion** was passed. More information on the Committee in future Session Meetings.

Heather also discussed with Session the walkway to the gym area to have it resealed.

Budget and Finance-Rich Hopkins/Heather McIntyre

Banking Summary presented year to date. Weekly Plate Spreadsheet was given out, from January 1, 2020 through February 17, 2020. This was reviewed by Heather to the Session. Heather will reach out to Dennis Duryea at the Duryea Agency in April/May for our Annual Insurance Review. Dennis will most likely be scheduled to come and speak to Session at that time.

Rich spoke with The Law Office of Bill Buchanan regarding the Hunter Estate. There is a document that Bill Buchanan has in his possession, and Rich will follow up and update Session accordingly.

Youth Group Ministry/Sunday School- Mark Dudick/Carol Griffiths

Mark will reach out to Nate Wilson the director of the New Hope Youth Group and see if they would like to participate in our Friday Night Hang here at the church. An update will be coming shortly.

Junior Deacons-Carol gave Session a handout from Danielle Griffiths regarding the Junior Deacons. The Deacons will discuss this handout at their upcoming meeting. There will be a meeting with Danielle and the parents of the future Junior Deacons at a meeting after church on either March 8th or 22nd 2020.

Elders-Are to continue Pastoral Care.


