Hymn Time:

"Trust and Obey"
John Sammis (1846-1919)

In 1886, Daniel Towner, director of the music department at Moody Bible Institute, was leading the music for evangelist D. L. Moody's series of meetings in Brockton, Massachusetts. A young man rose to give testimony, saying "I am not quite sure, but I am going to trust and I am going to obey." Mr. Towner jotted down this statement and sent it to his friend John Sammis, a Presbyterian minister and later a teacher at Moody. John wrote today's hymn based upon those words from that new believer.

Salvation is God's responsibility. Our responsibility is to trust in that salvation and then to obey its truths. This hymn represents a balanced view of a believer's trust in Christ's redemptive work, and it speaks of the resulting desire to obey Him and do His will in our daily lives. Then, and only then, do we experience real peace and joy.


