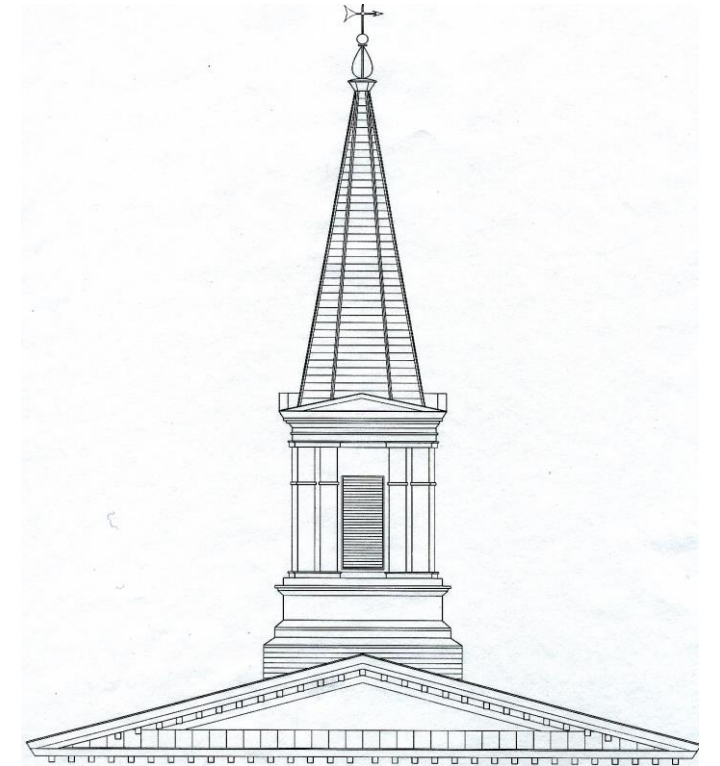

Hymn Time:

"He Leadeth Me"
Joseph Gilmore (1834-1918)

Joseph was born in Boston, MA., and was a graduate of Brown University and the Newton Theological Institution. He was ordained to the Baptist ministry in 1862. He published various literary works, but he is best known for our hymn today "He leadeth me, O blessed thought." The words for this hymn were written by Joseph in 1859, and the music was written by William Bradbury.

The hymn, is somewhat widely known, and was written in the First Baptist Church, Philadelphia PA. It was written at a close of a lecture done by Joseph. This hymn is in the *Baptist Hymnal (and Tune) Book*, and our *Celebration Hymnal*. As well as being an ordained minister, he was also a professor, and in 1868 he was appointed to the English Faculty at the University of Rochester, NY, and continued there until his retirement in 1911.
