“O, Worship the King”
Robert Grant (1779-1838)

Robert Grant was a member of a distinguished British political family, a member of the Parliament of Scotland, and governor of Bomby, India for a time. He also established a medical college in Bombay. Despite theses lofty credentials, Robert describes himself and all of us in this hymn as ‘frail children of dust, and feeble as frail’. When compared to our God and our Creator, these are indeed accurate descriptions. This sounds similar to what the apostle Paul has to say about his credentials in Philippians 3:4-9.

Robert has given us an excellent hymn for worship. It's descriptive names for exalting God are significant: Shield, Defender, Ancient of Days (see Daniel 7:9), Maker, Redeemer and Friend. Also note the vivid imagery: pavilioned in splendor, girded with praise, whose robe is the light, whose canopy space, chariots of wrath, and wings of the storm. This hymn should truly aid us in the worthy praise and adoration of our Heavenly King this morning.
