Hymn Time:

"Be Still My Soul" Katharina von Schlegel (1697-1768)

This hymn was originally written in German ("Stille meine Wille, dein Jesus hilft siegen") in 1752. Not much is known about Katharina, but that she had written many hymns over her lifetime. Be Still, My Soul was translated into English in 1855 by Jane L. Borthwick.

The music was added later by Finland native Jean Sibelius in 1899. The tune was then put to the words and appeared in *The Church Hymnary* in 1927, which was edited by and then brought to the United States by Welsh Scholar, David Evans. This was first used as a Presbyterian hymn in 1933, and has remained beloved.


