

Hymn Time:

"I Need Thee Every Hour"
Annie Sherwood Hawks (1835-1918)

Annie Sherwood Hawks, a thirty-seven-year-old Brooklyn, New York, housewife, wrote the words to this gospel hymn one morning in 1872 while she was doing her housework. On the following Sunday she showed her simple poem to the pastor of her church, Reverend Robert Lowry, minister at the Hanson Place Baptist Church, who himself was a composer as well as a preacher. Lowry took them home, set them to music, added a chorus of his own, and a famous hymn was born.

I need Thee every hour, Most gracious Lord;
No tender voice like Thine Can peace afford.
I need Thee, O I need Thee,
Every hour I need Thee;
O bless me now, my Savior, I come to Thee.
