Hymn Time:

"All Glory, Laud and Honor" Theodulph of Orleans (760-821)

This Palm Sunday hymn was written approximately A.D. 820 by Bishop Theodulph of Orleans, France, while he was imprisoned at the monastery of Angers. Theodulph was well known in his day as a poet, pastor and beloved bishop of Orleans. When Emperor Charlemagne died in 814, the bishop was put into a monastic prison by Charlemagne's son and successor, Louis I the Pious, for allegedly plotting against him. A well-known legend has long been associated with this hymn. It is believed by many that a short time before Theodulph's death in 821, Louis was visiting in the area where Theodulph was imprisoned and by chance passed under his cell. The bishop is said to have been singing and worshiping by himself. When the emperor heard the song we will sing today being sung by Theodulph, he was so moved that he immediately ordered Theodulph's release.


