#### Hymn Time:

"All People That On Earth Do Dwell" William Kethe (died 1594)

William Kethe was born in Scotland in the early 16th century. He was a contemporary of another Scotsman, John Knox, the leader of the Protestant Reformation in Scotland and founder of the Presbyterian Church.

William Keth spent a great deal of time in exile for his faith. He lived in Frankfurt, Germany, and then Geneva, Switzerland. While in Geneva he helped translate the Geneva Bible in 1560. His version of Psalm 100 was originally referred to as "The Old Hundredth". Today it is universally known by its first line - "All People That On Earth Do Dwell". After returning to England, William served as vicar during the reign of Elizabeth I, and later served as a military chaplain.

William may have had a hard life, being constantly on the move for his faith. But you can't tell that from the first two lines of today's hymn: All people that on earth do dwell, sing to the Lord with cheerful voice." Let us sing all of this morning's hymns with that same cheerful voice.


