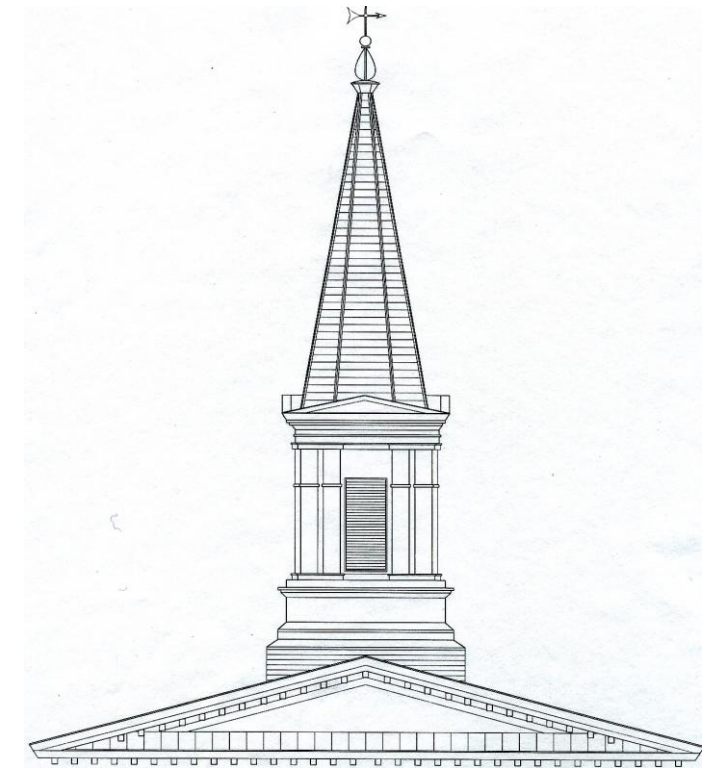

A Short History of Shad

According to an old legend among the Mi'Kmaq of eastern Canada and northern New England, an unhappy porcupine appealed to the Great Spirit to change his lot in life. The Great Spirit turned the creature inside out and tossed him in the river. Thus, the shad was born.

There's only one reason the mild, sweet-fleshed shad isn't a mainstay of the dinner table, or rather, there are hundreds: all those bones. The American Shad skeleton is notoriously difficult to navigate, so demand for the fish has diminished over the years, as has the population of the species in the Delaware River and elsewhere.

For comparison, the largest season-long haul on record is 9,288 in 1896. Hefty hauls continued through the 1930's, when pollution started to take its toll on the Delaware River shad.

The fish still has its fans. Among recreational fishermen, the American shad are known to be elusive and put up a good fight. Gourmets still prize the torpedo-shaped lobes of roe traditionally fried in bacon fat. And scientists and environmentalists consider the delicate fish a barometer of the health of the river in which it swims.
