"Give Me Jesus"

Fanny Crosby (1820-1915)

Though blinded at six weeks of age through improper medical treatment, Fanny Crosby wrote more than 8,000 gospel song texts in her lifetime of 95 years. She travelled extensively in her later years as a speaker throughout the country. Fanny said it was her continual prayer that God would allow her to lead to Christ every person she contacted. Once, Fanny was talking to one of her neighbors, who complained bitterly of his poverty. "If I had wealth, I would be able to do just what I wish to do; and I would be able to make an appearance in the world." Fanny replied, "well, take the world, but give me Jesus." She was here inspired by her own words to write the hymn that we sing at the close of today's service.

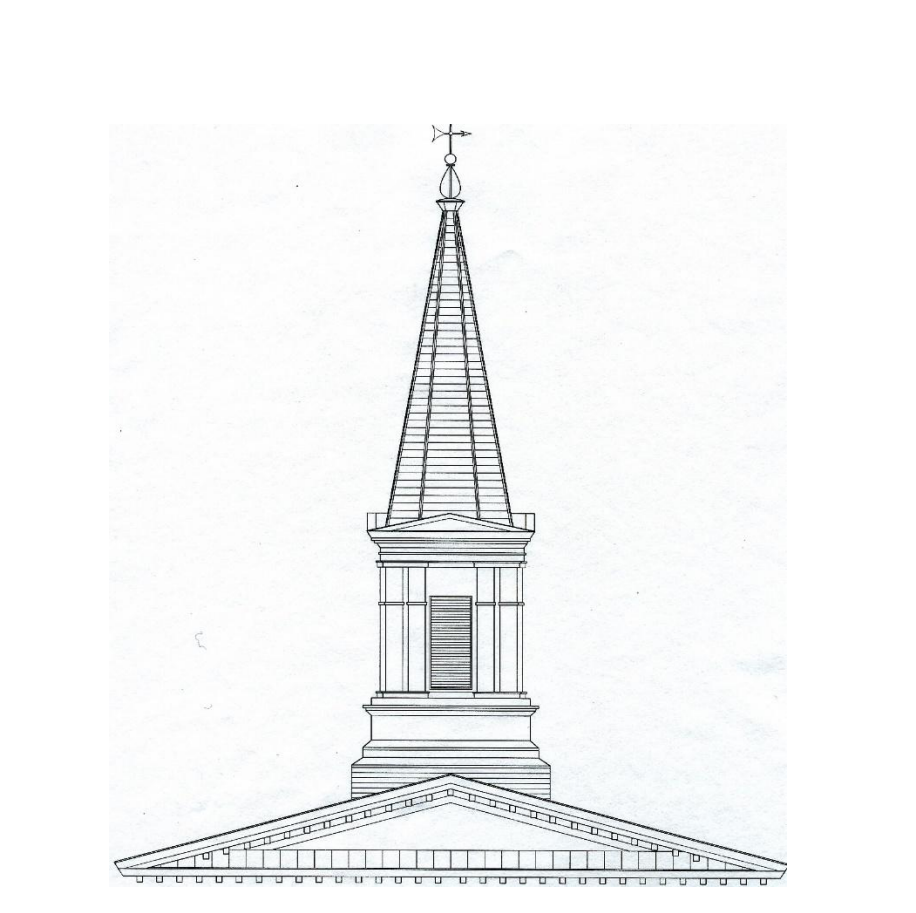
