### Hymn Time:

"This is My Father's World" Maltbie Babcock (1858-1901)

Maltbie revealed his great admiration of nature in this lovely hymn. He was recognized as one of the outstanding Presbyterian ministers of his generation, pastoring churches in New York and Maryland. Maltbie was also a skilled athlete who enjoyed all outdoor activity. He was a pitcher and captain of the Syracuse University baseball team, as well as a varsity swimmer. Maltbie especially loved his early morning walks. He would always comment to his wife, "I'm going out to see my Father's world".

Since Maltbie was also an accomplished performer on the organ, the piano and the violin, we can see why nature seemed to him to be "the music of the spheres". In addition to being a tribute to nature, this hymn is a triumphant assertion of the unfailing power of God and the assurance of Christ's eventual reign. As Maltbie wrote, "Jesus who died shall be satisfied, and earth and heaven be one".

Maltbie published nothing during his life. After his untimely death from fever while visiting the Holy Land, his wife collected and published many of Maltbie's writings, including today's hymn.


