

Hymn Time:

“Once to Every Man and Nation”
James Russell Lowell (1819-1891)

In the year 1845 at the same time Abraham Lincoln was opposing in Congress, the agitators for a war with Mexico, the famed poet James Russell Lowell was using his talent to speak out against what he thought was the plan of the slave-holding states to gain more territory. It was a 90-line poem, later reduced to 32 lines, which became one of the strongest hymns challenging national righteousness ever printed:

*Once to every man and nation
Comes the moment to decide,
In the strife of truth with falsehood,
For the good or evil side.*

Legend says that the tune used for this hymn can be traced back to its discovery in a bottle washed up on the shores of Wales.
