"What a Friend We Have in Jesus" Joseph Scriven (1819-1886)

Joseph had wealth, education, a devoted family and a pleasant life in his native Ireland. Then unexpected tragedy entered. On the day before Joseph's wedding, his fiancée was thrown from her horse and drowned. In his deep sorrow, Joseph realized that he could find the comfort and support he needed only in his dearest friend, Jesus.

Joseph left Ireland for Port Hope, Canada and dramatically changed his lifestyle. He was determined to devote all of his extra time in being a friend and helper to others. Joseph often gave away his clothes and possessions to those in need. He worked, without pay, for anyone who needed him. Joseph became known as "the Good Samaritan of Port Hope".

When Joseph's mother became ill in Ireland, he wrote her a letter and enclosed the words of his newly written poem. Joseph's prayer was that his poem would remind his mother that she had a never-failing heavenly Friend. Later, a friend who came to visit Joseph happened to see the poem in Joseph's home. The friend read the poem and asked Joseph, "Who wrote these beautiful words?" Joseph replied, "The Lord and I did it between us."

As we sing Joseph's poem this morning, pledge to make an effort to spend more time this week with your never-failing heavenly Friend.


