Hymn Time:

"The Old Rugged Cross."
George Bennard (1873-1958)

George was born in Youngstown Ohio. When he was a child, the family moved to Iowa. He served with the Salvation Army in Iowa for several years before he became an ordained Minister in the Methodist Episcopal Church. He wrote the words and tune for his best-known hymn "The Old Rugged Cross" in 1913. *The Old Rugged Cross* uses a sentimental popular song form, and it speaks of the writer's adoration of Christ and His sacrifice at Calvary.

Since the 1950s and beyond, "The Old Rugged Cross" has been a country gospel favorite. Especially since it was used as the title of Ernest Tubb's gospel album; and it has been performed by some of the twentieth century's most important recording artists, like Ella Fitzgerald, Willie Nelson and Ronnie Milsap.

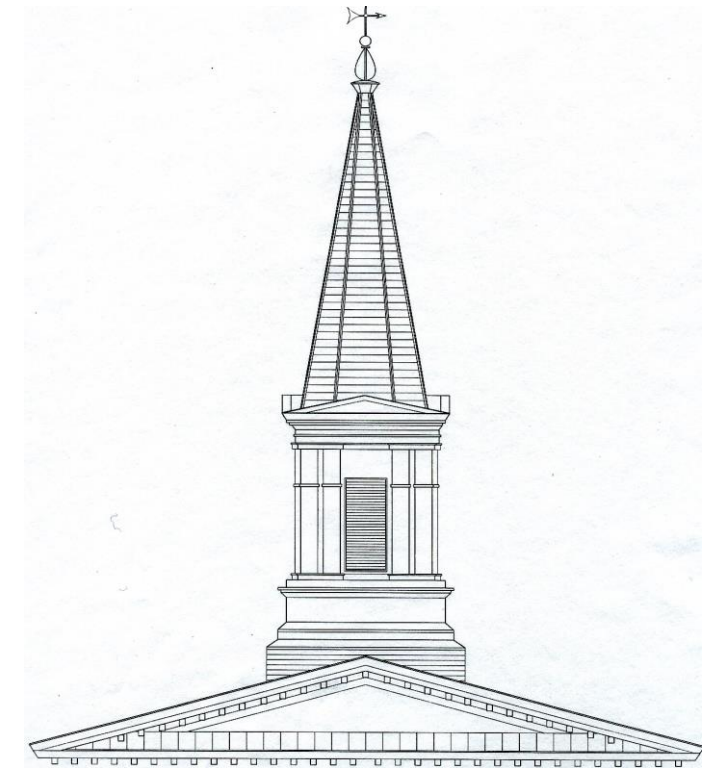
