***We bring the sacrifice of praise
written in 1984***

In their church in Grand Prairie, Texas, Kirk and Deby Dearman had just heard a guest speaker talk about bringing a sacrifice of praise to church with them. On the way home, Kirk told Deby that there should be a song about that, so – as they were driving down the freeway – Kirk began thinking about how such a song should sound. In 5 minutes, he had the entire song in his mind, and when they arrived home, he played and sang it for Deby. They now call it their “car tune”.

Those were days when life was going well for the Dearmans. Deby was a model, making a thousand dollars a day. Kirk was on staff at a growing church, and was writing songs on a regular basis. They hardly knew what sacrifice was. But then the Lord called them to be foreign missionaries; they quit their jobs, sold their home, and went from having lots of money to being broke. They spent the next decade in Europe.

Kirk says, “Our worship is most precious to the Lord when we’re in places of affliction.”

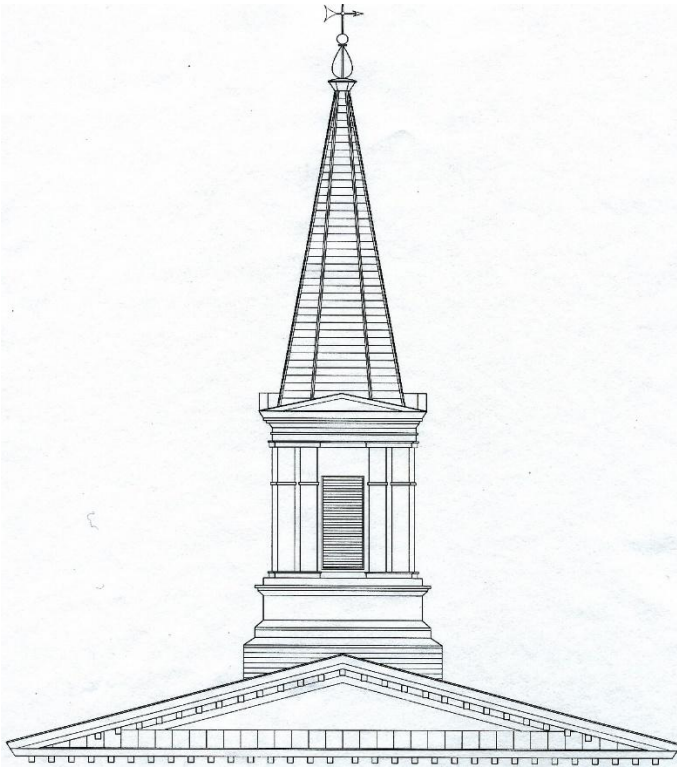
