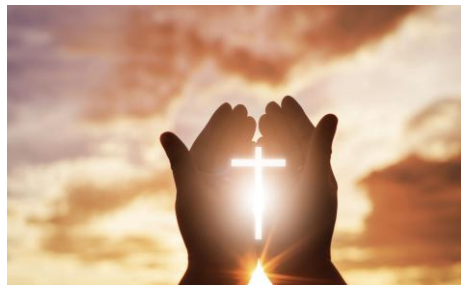
Today is Communion Sunday and Phil McCloughan will perform the communion service.

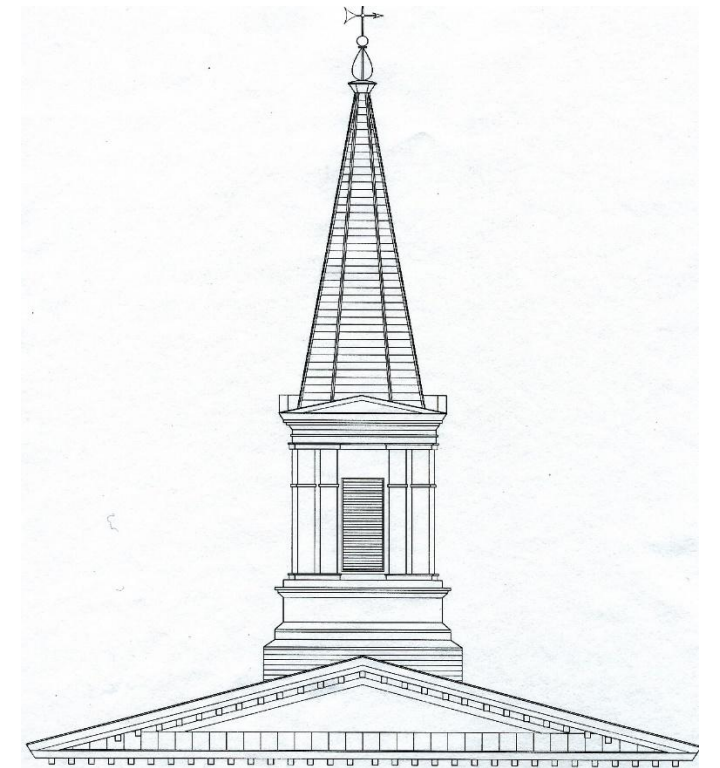

"O For a Thousand Tongues"
Charles Wesley (1707-1788)

Right after graduating from Oxford University, John and Charles Wesley decided to sail to Ameica. They came to the New World to evangelize the colonists in Georgia and the Indians. The Wesleys soon became disillusioned with the situation and returned to England after only a short time.

As they crossed the Atlantic, John and Charles were very impressed by a group of devout Moravians who seemed to have such spiritual depth and vitality, as well as a heart for lost souls. After returning to London, the Wesleys met with some Moravians in May of 1738. Both brothers had a "heart-warming" experience, realizing that even though they had been zealous in religious activity, neither of them had ever personally known either God's forgiveness or real joy. From that time on, their ministry displayed a new dimension of spiritual power.

This morning's hymn was written by Charles in 1749 on the 11th anniversary of his conversion experience. It was inspired by a chance remark made by a friend who expressed his spiritual joy to Charles in this way: "Oh Brother Charles, the Lord has done so much for my life. Had I a thousand tongues, I would praise Christ Jesus with every one of them!"

Let us make every effort to do the same today.
