

"Take My Life and Let It Be"  
Frances Ridley Havergal (1836-1879)

Today's hymn was written by the woman who had become widely known throughout England as "the consecration poet". It was said of Frances that she always lived her words before she wrote them. Frances' life was one of constant and complete commitment to God. Her many talents - an accomplished pianist and vocalist, proficiency in seven languages, a keen mind (memorization of the entire New Testament, Psalms, Isaiah and the Minor Prophets) - were all dedicated to serving God.

Her musical talents could have brought her much worldly fame. However, she determined that her life's mission to sing and work only for Jesus. Verse two says, "Take my voice and let me sing always, only for my King". The line in verse three was also sincerely phrased, "Take my silver and my gold, not a mite would I withhold". At one time Frances gathered together her many fine pieces of jewelry and other family heirlooms and shipped them to the church missionary house to be used for evangelizing the lost.

***About the Message:***

*Think for a moment, are you more or less busy now than at any other point of your lives? For those who are "retired," are you more busy, more going here and there? Are your days more exhausting than in your working or raising kids days? For me, I am far, far more "busy", running about here and there, keeping this and that commitment or obligation, than most days of my "working" years. Why is that? I think we all are very prone to fall into the cult of "Busy-ness." As long as we are busy, running here and there, keeping all plates spinning, and all balls in the air all at once, we think are pleasing God or doing His will? The people of God, at the time of the Second Temple during time of Micah, thought so as well. God had something to say about that, as He has so with us today. What does God really require of us? It's in the Scriptures today, and it's not our Busy-ness.*
