Hymn Time:

"Once to Every Man and Nation"
James Russell Lowell, (1819-1891)

In the year 1845, at the same time Abraham Lincoln was opposing in Congress the agitators for a war with Mexico, the famed poet James Russell Lowell was using his talent to speak out against what he thought was the plan of the slave-holding states to gain more territory. It was a 90-line poem, later reduced to 32 lines, which became one of the strongest hymns challenging national righteousness ever printed:

Once to every man and nation
Comes the moment to decide,
In the strife of truth with falsehood,
For the good or evil side.

Legend says that the tune used for this hymn can be traced back to its discovery in a bottle washed up on the shores of Wales.


