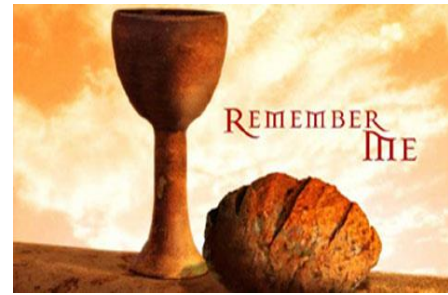


Today's Announcements:

Hymn Time:

"How Great Thou Art"
Carl Boberg (1859-1940)

Today's inspiring hymn of praise and adoration reminds us of God's unlimited power and love in creation and redemption. Although written in 1886, the hymn has become familiar just since the close of World War II. It especially became an international favorite after the Billy Graham Evangelistic Team used it in their crusades during the late 1940's and early 1950's.

Carl Boberg was a Swedish pastor. While visiting a beautiful country estate in 1886, Carl was caught in a sudden thunderstorm. The awesome and violent lightning and thunder quickly ended, leaving clear brilliant sunshine and the calm, sweet singing of the birds in the trees. Falling on his knees in awe and adoration of the Almighty God, Carl wrote this hymn of praise.

Take a moment now to think about the greatness of God and His wonderful redeeming love for each of us.

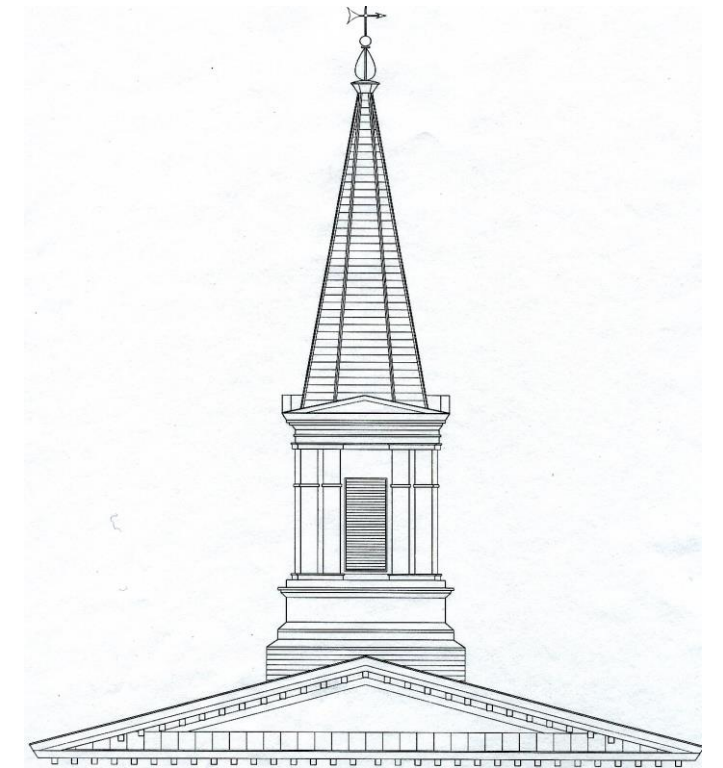
